Adjective Use Checklist

- 1) Does the **adjective** agree with another **noun** in gender, number, and case?
 - a) No substantive use (e.g. $dy\alpha\theta\delta\zeta = a \text{ good man}$)
 - b) Yes Does the **adjective** have an article <u>immediately</u> in front of it with which it agrees in gender, number, and case?
 - i) No Does the **noun** with which the **adjective** agrees have the article?
 - (1) No attributive or predicate use (context will determine whether λόγος ἀγαθός = the good word/the word is good)
 - (2) Yes predicate use (e.g. $\dot{\alpha}\gamma\alpha\theta\dot{\delta}\zeta$ $\dot{\delta}$ $\lambda\dot{\delta}\gamma\delta\zeta$ = the word is good)
 - ii) Yes attributive use (e.g. ὁ ἀγαθὸς λόγος = the good word)
