

## Adjective Use Checklist

- 1) Does the **adjective** agree with another **noun** in gender, number, and case?
  - a) No – substantive use (e.g. ἀγαθός = a good man)
  - b) Yes – Does the **adjective** have an article immediately in front of it with which it agrees in gender, number, and case?
    - i) No – Does the **noun** with which the **adjective** agrees have the article?
      - (1) No – attributive or predicate use (context will determine whether λόγος ἀγαθός = the good word/the word is good)
      - (2) Yes – predicate use (e.g. ἀγαθὸς ὁ λόγος = the word is good)
    - ii) Yes – attributive use (e.g. ὁ ἀγαθὸς λόγος = the good word)
